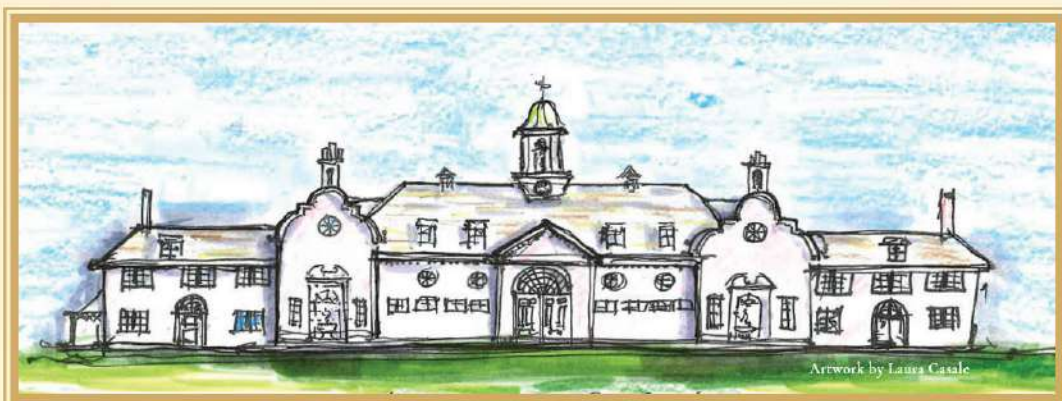

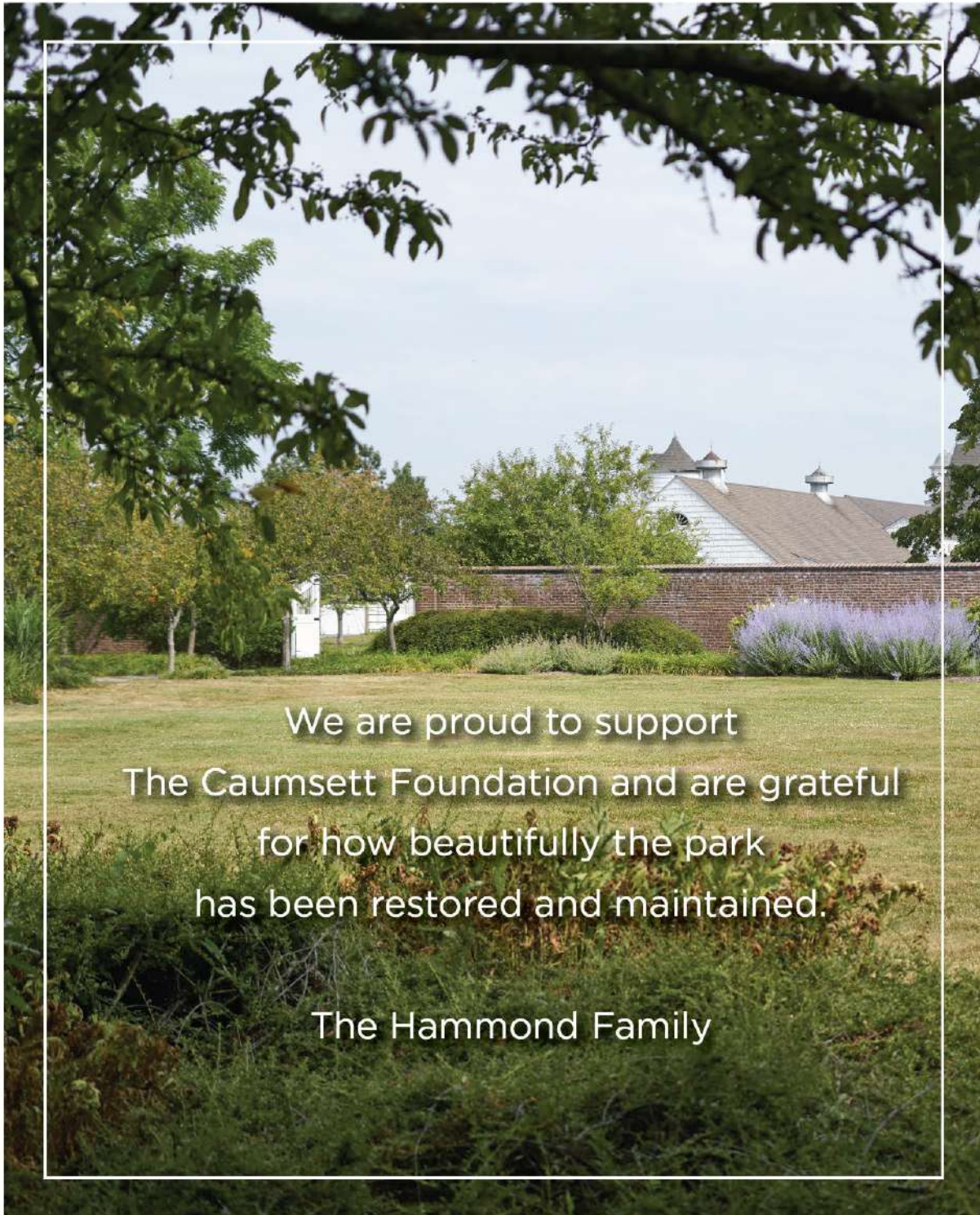

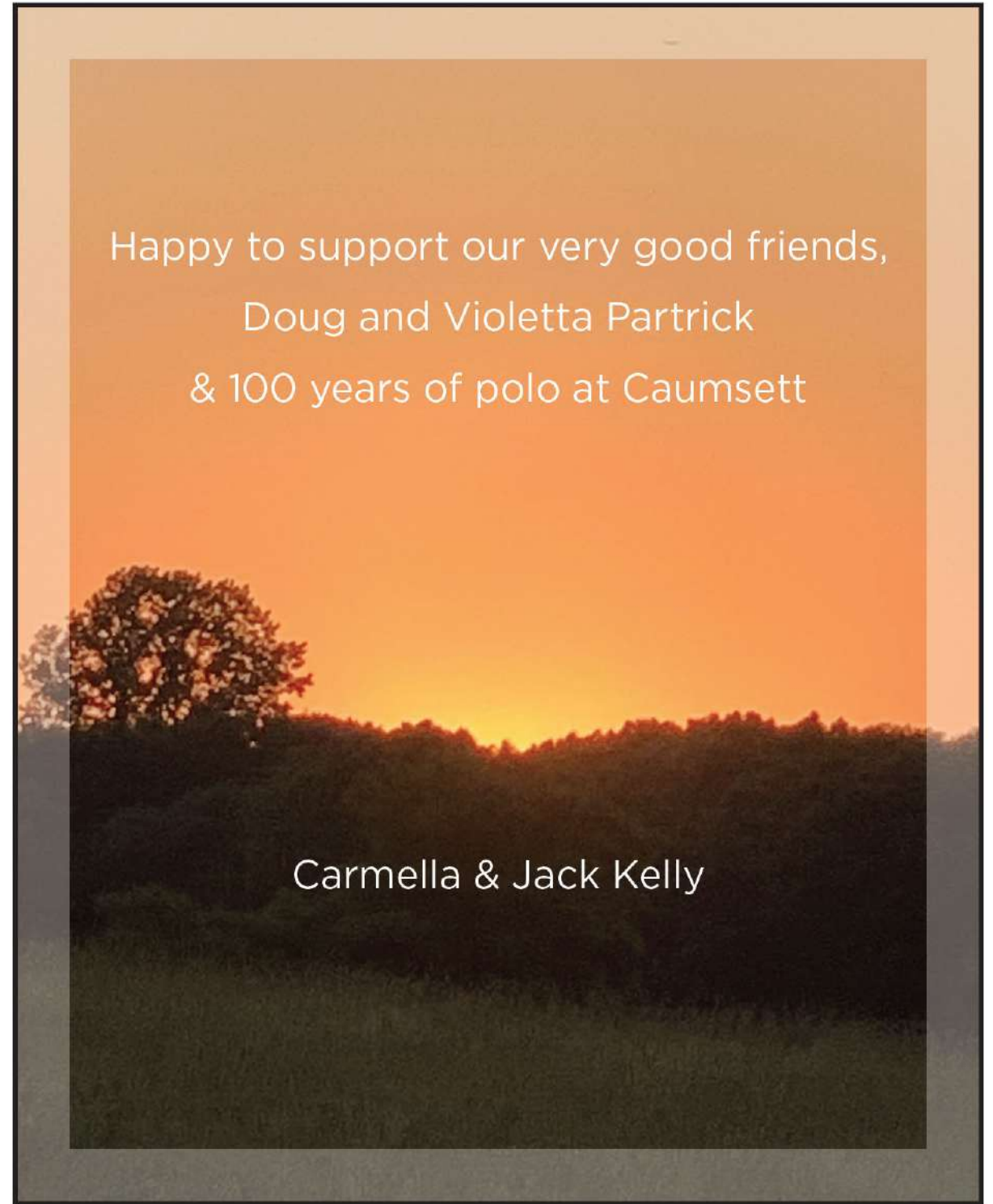

# The 5 Rules of Polo

Did you know that polo is one of the world's oldest team sports?

Once called the Sport of Kings, there are five essential rules that make polo a unique and exciting sport to watch today!

## 1. Line of the Ball and Right of Way.

The line of the ball is an imaginary path the ball creates when struck. Players must respect this line to avoid dangerous collisions. The player with the right of way, usually the last to hit the ball, cannot be crossed by others.



## 2. Score goals to win.

The object of the game is to hit the ball between the opposing team's goalposts to score a point, which is called a goal. The team with the most goals at the end of the match wins. If tied, extra play is used to determine the winner.



## 3. Games are divided into chukkers.

A match consists of periods called chukkers, each lasting 7 or 7.5 minutes. Most games have 4 to 6 chukkers. Players change horses between chukkers to keep the ponies fresh.



## 4. Four players per team

Each team has four players, each with a specific numbered position (from 1 to 4), playing both offense and defense. Roles are based on numbers, but teamwork and fast switching are essential.



## 5. Physical plays like ride-offs, bumps, and hooks are allowed but must be done safely.

Players can use ride-offs or gentle bumps to move an opponent away from the line of the ball, but these maneuvers have strict safety limits!



# Caumsett 2025

The Caumsett Foundation is celebrating another extraordinary year of Park improvements, expanded programming and remarkable community support.

This past year marked a banner year for storytelling and historic preservation with the completion of three films about Caumsett. We produced a biographical film about the life of the last living employee of the Caumsett Estate Alfie Kuntz, as well as a comprehensive history film chronicling Caumsett's journey from the time of Native Americans through the Revolutionary period to its days as the Gold Coast estate of Marshall Field III, and finally to its current status as a modern-day park preserve. The third film focused on the dairy production process at Caumsett, highlighting the estate's role in supplying fresh milk and showcasing the daily operations that sustained its community. In May we premiered the films at the Huntington Cinema Arts Centre, bringing Caumsett's rich history to our wide audience of members and supporters.

Our Sunset Music Series experienced tremendous growth in 2025, expanding from its usual May and June schedule to include Sunday concerts throughout September, bringing our total to 12 concerts. The expanded programming has created even more opportunities for our community to enjoy diverse performances ranging from popular music to jazz, bluegrass, funk and soul in our beautiful setting.

Spring at Caumsett brought renewed energy to our thriving Artist in Residence Program, which runs from April through October and expanded significantly in 2025 to include 8 talented artists. For varying lengths of time, each artist is given the studio which was adapted from an old Van Shed to engage with the unique history and environment of Caumsett State Historic Park Preserve. A major milestone in 2025 was the addition of our first Executive Director, Michael Gurtowski, whose position is supported by a two-year grant from Parks and Trails New York. This leadership addition has enabled us to expand our



programming and deepen our impact throughout the community.

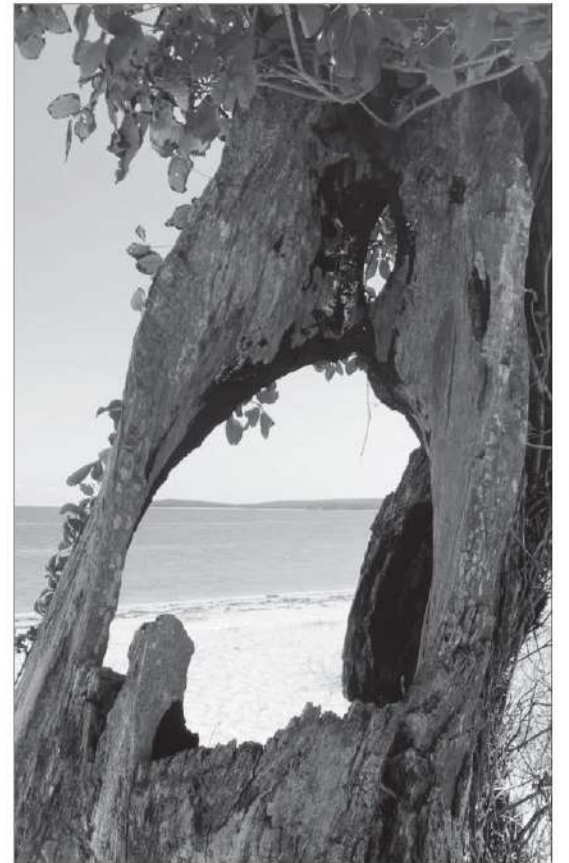
We continued to enhance our programming with exciting new events. We expanded our popular Egg Hunt and spring celebration by adding a low-sensory egg hunt option, making this tradition accessible to children with sensory sensitivities. Our wellness programming flourished in 2025 as well. We continued our free yoga program in the Walled Garden and added weekly tai chi sessions every Saturday from June through August, providing even more opportunities for peaceful practice in our beautiful natural setting.

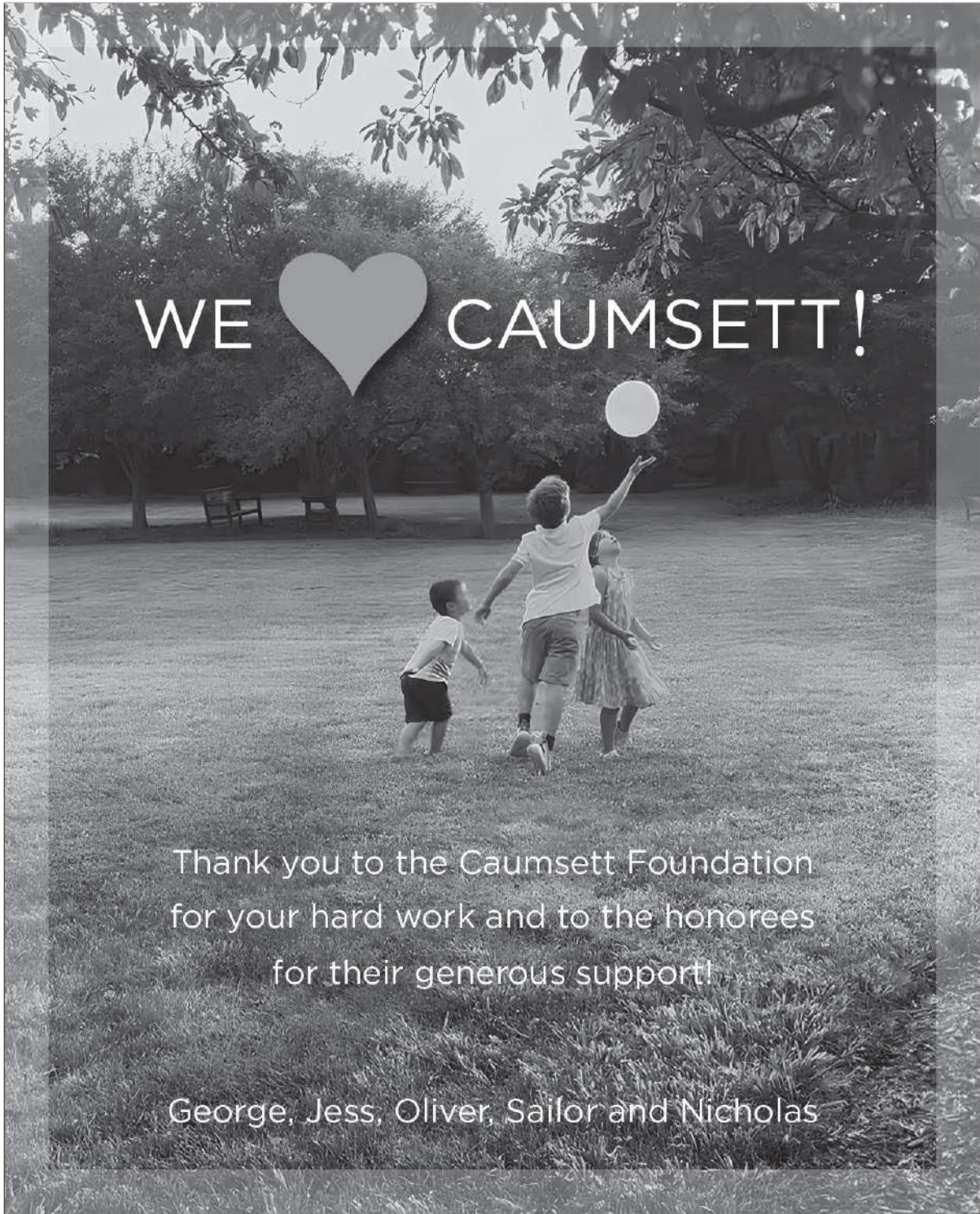
The holiday season brought a magical new tradition with our first-ever holiday tree and Menorah lighting ceremony in December 2024, which was so well-received that we will continue this celebration in December 2025.

Caring for the special ecological environments at Caumsett remains at the forefront of our mission. The Environmental Committee continued working on the Butterfly Hill Restoration Project in its second year of the three-year grant from the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation for managing the highly invasive porcelain berry vine. This year we were extraordinarily fortunate to have the dedicated work of two exceptional environmental interns, Lauren Kelly and Sam Iglesias, who joined our team through the DEC grant funding. These talented young conservationists have contributed significantly to our environmental stewardship efforts, working tirelessly on digging out, weed whacking and mowing the invasive porcelain berry species on Butterfly Hill.

The Environmental Committee is also in the final stages of completing the erosion study for the hillside behind the Main House, a critical assessment that will help guide future conservation and stabilization efforts for this important area of the Park.
